The AI Summer School 2026 is open to international participants from non-Polish higher education institutions.

Applications are invited from:

- **Students**
- **PhD candidates**
- **Academic staff holding a PhD degree (PhD holders)**

Applicants must be currently enrolled in or employed by a foreign (non-Polish) university, demonstrate a strong academic interest in the thematic focus of the programme, and hold English language proficiency at a minimum level of B2.

The event will take place in Warsaw, Poland, from 23 to 30 May 2026 and will bring together an international academic community to engage in advanced, interdisciplinary dialogue on the impact of artificial intelligence on management, economics, law, marketing, finance, and the broader social sciences.

This exceptional initiative will, for the first time, convene leading and emerging scholars specialising in artificial intelligence and management sciences within a single, integrated research-oriented programme. Beyond knowledge exchange, the event is designed as a platform for building international research networks, developing joint research agendas, and initiating future interdisciplinary projects addressing AI-driven transformations of organisations, markets, governance, and society.

The first round of applications is open until 28 February 2026.

The recruitment process is conducted in accordance with the principles of equal opportunity and non-discrimination, and all applications are evaluated solely on academic merit and relevance to the programme's scope.

Scholarship and Financial Support

All selected participants will receive a comprehensive financial support package, covering participation, living expenses, and travel costs.

1. Scholarship (individual allowance)

- 600 PLN (approx. 140 EUR) – for students
- 1000 PLN (approx. 233 EUR) – for PhD candidates and PhD holders

2. Living allowance

- 2400 PLN (approx. 558 EUR) – lump sum to cover accommodation and daily living expenses during the programme.

Travel allowance

A travel lump sum is granted based on the distance between Warsaw (Poland) and the participant's country of residence. The amount depends on the assigned distance group:

- Group 1 – 1000 PLN (approx. 233 EUR)
- Group 2 – 1500 PLN (approx. 349 EUR)
- Group 3 – 2000 PLN (approx. 465 EUR)
- Group 4 – 3000 PLN (approx. 698 EUR)
- Group 5 – 4500 PLN (approx. 1,047 EUR)
- Group 6 – 6500 PLN (approx. 1,512 EUR)

Important Administrative Information

Due to formal programme regulations, scholarships and allowances cannot be paid in advance. Financial support will be disbursed after arrival in Warsaw and upon completion of all required administrative procedures with the University of Warsaw.

Currency Conversion Note

Indicative EUR amounts are calculated using the exchange rate:

1 EUR = 4.30 PLN.

All payments are made in PLN in accordance with programme regulations.
